The goal of Thunderbird Partnership Foundation's "Sacred Breath of Life" campaign is to help create awareness, understanding, and engagement amongst First Nations leaders and community members (including affected individuals and families), of the positive outcomes of harm reduction.

The core message is focused on the role we all have in protecting the sacred breath of life and asks us to consider harm reduction as a form of medicine – just as community, connection, shelter, fire, and more act as medicines to help heal and nourish us. We are asking folks to consider how harm reduction, rooted in First Nations culture and ways of knowing, can have the power to keep people alive.

Together, we want to shift understanding about First Nations-led harm reduction approaches, and we're inviting you to be part of that.
